- Day 5 Each day the Mission Hills challenges test your abilities a little more - today is no exception as you encounter the World Cup Course designed by Jack Nicklaus. (B)
- Day 6 After breakfast, you'll head off for your final round at Mission Hills. Today you'll take on what's reputed to be Asia's most difficult course - the Norman Course. Freshen up after golf and then you'll be transferred to the airport your onward flight. (B)
