Below is our suggested stay & play tour package that is based on rounds played Monday to Friday. Suggested Itinerary:

- Day 1 On arrival to Haikou Airport, you'll be met and transferred to Mission Hills Haikou. Relax after check-in and familiarise yourself with the impressive Mission Hills complex and its wonderful amenities.
- Day 2 After breakfast, your caddy & cart will be waiting to escort you along your first Mission Hills challenge on the Sandbelt Trails Course - AM tee time TBA. Depicting an Australian inspired design, expect to encounter difficult bunkers and a landscape of native grasses, yuccas & eucalypt trees. (B)
- Day 3 Today you'll encounter a different golfing assignment when you play the traditionally designed Vintage Course - AM tee time TBA. Your cart and caddy will be waiting to escort you along the narrow tree-lined fairways of a course that has a staggering 175 bunkers to negotiate. (B)
- Day 4 Your 3rd day's play this morning will see you take on the Stone Quarry Course - AM tee time TBA. With a Pete Dye inspired design, features of abrupt mounds & moguls, pot bunkers and devilishly small green - accuracy will be a must to record a good score. (B)
- Day 5 After breakfast, you'll head off for your final round at Mission Hills' Haikou. Today you'll play on the signature Blackstone Course - AM tee time TBA. Freshen up after golf and then you'll be transferred to Haikou Railway Station for a high-speed rail trip to Sanya. Upon arrival to Sanya Railway Station, you'll be met and transferred to your 5-star Yalong Bay Resort. After checking in, relax and familiarize yourself with the beautiful seaside resort. (B)
- Day 6 Today you'll be transferred to the 27-hole Sun Valley Resort. Here you'll play two out of the three 9-hole courses which will ensure a variety of challenging holes - AM tee times TBA. After golf you'll be transferred back to your resort to relax. (B)
- Day 7 This morning after breakfast you'll take a short transfer to Yalong Bay Golf Club for round that will undoubtedly test your abilities - AM tee time TBA. Designed by Robert Trent Jones, Yalong Bay is a picturesque course with a number of water hazards and other interesting challenges. After your round you'll be transferred back to your resort. (B)

Day 8

Check-out after breakfast and bid farewell to Yalong Bay and then you'll be transferred to Sanya Airport for your onward journey. (B)
